Mr. Campbell graduated *magna cum laude* from Washington & Lee University, where he lettered four years on the Generals varsity football team and received one of the university's highest honors as his class's graduation speaker. Mr. Campbell then served as a missionary with Athletes in Action in China while also studying Mandarin at the Shanghai University of Sport. He returned to Dallas to pursue his law degree, where he was the President of the SMU Law Review and again graduated *magna cum laude*. Mr. Campbell is a Blackstone Legal Fellow and now serves on the *Emerging Leaders Board* at SMU Dedman School of Law.

EXPERIENCE

Mr. Campbell has extensive experience litigating in a diverse array of practice areas across state and federal courts throughout the United States. He has defended major national companies in federal and state antitrust cases from coast to coast—including state courts in California and Texas and federal courts in Texas and Georgia—as well as in federal and state antitrust investigations throughout the United States. On the opposite end of the spectrum, he has represented microcap companies, both defending against and suing predatory toxic note lenders in federal court. And his practice has encompassed nearly everything in between, including successfully arguing at the Fifth Circuit Court of Appeals regarding Texas insurance law, defending against catastrophic injury in Texas state court, litigating and counseling employers on labor and employment matters, defending against and pursuing breach of contract and UCC claims in Texas state court, arbitrating construction litigation claims based in Louisiana, investigating and advising on data breach and cyber security matters for multinational corporations, and pursuing First Amendment and related religious liberty claims in federal court in New York as part of his dedicated pro bono work. Mr. Campbell even spent six months prosecuting misdemeanors for the City of Carrollton, where he compiled a 100% conviction rate. A common thread connecting his diverse practice has been his expertise in electronic discovery, which he has routinely leveraged to achieve significant savings for his clients as well as pursue creative and aggressive strategies against his opponents.
